INTERCULTURAL COMMUNICATIVE TRAINING OF FUTURE LAWYERS

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These days English has the status of a language of international communication, and people who are fluent in it, can get a prestige job that will be a source of stable income. Foreign language in particular is becoming more important in modern society as a means of intercultural communication between professionals in the legal profession.

Any lawyer must speak fluently, be able to find words correctly, speak orally and in writing, because he needs to use appropriate terminology to state facts, persuade, easily explain the content of the document to the client and in court. And it is amazing if the lawyer has the ability to do it in English.

However, not everyone understands why lawyers need to know English at a higher level than every day. Here we are going to give some points why and where they may need it:

- Civil servants are required to speak a foreign language by law

Thus, Article 20 of the Law on Civil Service stipulates that a person applying for a civil service position, in addition to meeting other requirements, must speak a language that is one of the official languages of the Council of Europe. And the final provisions state that the Law enters into force on May 1, 2016, except for paragraph 1 of the second part of Article 20 of this Law in terms of foreign language proficiency, which is one of the official languages of the Council of Eu-

rope, which enters into force two years after its entry into force. Though, civil servants have no way out as to improve their English or French skills.

- Work with documents in a foreign language

This is especially true for lawyers specializing in commercial and international law, consulting and corporate lawyers. After all, the scope of lawyers is very wide, it covers all aspects of public life, so for those who want to expand their scope and work with foreign clients, and accordingly receive higher fees, it is better to possess a good level of English.

A lawyer working with documents in a foreign language needs to be well versed in what he is doing. Is it worth talking about how high the cost of error can be? For the company, this can result in loss of reputation, huge fines, loss of financial benefits and many other unpleasant consequences.

- For negotiations

Of course, this also applies to working with foreign companies. However, we have deliberately highlighted this as a separate point, as communication skills - fluency in professional terms - require special skills. This may include not only work with documents, advice and assistance in doing business, but also the activities of a mediator, which is becoming increasingly popular in resolving disputes. If working with documents allows you to spend more time on it - you can peek at a word you are not familiar with, use a translator, reread twice, then in live communication, you need to think fast, and speak clearly and understandably, which clearly requires considerable training and long training.

- Additional income due to translation of legal texts into a foreign language

A specialist who knows his business and speaks a foreign language will always have the opportunity to earn extra money through translations of special legal texts.

- Participation in international conferences

Both Ukrainian and international events, such as conferences, forums, round tables or seminars, are always an opportunity to share experiences, gain new knowledge, find new clients or establish relationships with colleagues. Accordingly, if you have the opportunity to participate in international events, it gives you more opportunities for personal development and growth of your company.

Foreign language is becoming very important in modern society and in various areas of professional activity. Knowledge of a foreign language is an integral part of the training of a modern lawyer. The study of a foreign language in the professional field of law is necessary for mastering a foreign language in its colloquial domestic and professional aspects in order to apply in various spheres of everyday life and in their future professional activities.
