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DEVELOPMENT OF MODERN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS DURING THE WAR

Introduction. War is a difficult period of existence of the country and its citizens. Military action is forcing the suspension or closure of educational institutions, shopping malls, cafes, factories and even farms. Thus, on February 24, the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine recommended to stop the educational process at educational institutions of all levels and send students on vacation. During the two-week vacation, some territories of Ukraine were occupied, and educators were forced to evacuate to western Ukraine or abroad.

The purpose of this study is to analyze a set of all factors that may affect students' training, namely:

- educational institutions situation after the start of a full-scale war in Ukraine;
- digital technologies development as a new era in education;
- programs for learning and development, and their possible role in the lives of students.

Because of hostilities on the territory of Ukraine, 1,138 educational institutions were damaged, 99 of which were completely destroyed [1]. However, any student who is an immigrant or if the university he studied at is destroyed, can continue his studies at any other higher education institution. He should just write a statement. Such an application can be submitted electronically, which also greatly facilitates the process of re-registration [3].

The development of digital technologies can be called a «new era» in education. One gadget can replace an entire library and a word search system allows you to find the information you need in seconds. In general, digitalization

has become a really integral part of the educational process. Computer technology allows teachers to conduct classes anywhere in the world just having the Internet access. Every educational institution now has an electronic journal, a modular environment, and an electronic library. Some of the most popular platforms for distance learning are [2]:

- MOODLE (opportunity to create courses, make a study schedule, control the quality of knowledge);

- GOOGLE CLASSROOM (free platform for easy student learning).

In addition, each student has the opportunity to take a free course in any specialty on the following platforms:

- PROMETHEUS (a program with free and paid courses on various topics, which allows each student and educator to study in any field);

- ED-ERA (a modern online education studio that allows students to prepare for external evaluation, improve the skills of teachers and just develop in different directions).

Conclusion. We can conclude that modern higher education institutions are moving in the direction of digitalization, which allows them to attract as many students as possible, test the quality of their knowledge and helps each student to combine study with work, volunteering, travelling.

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
